

## “Aap ki Sarkar Aap ke Dwar” DDC Conducts Public Darbar at Tehsil Wakura, Ganderbal, Sep 12, 2017

In order to resolve people's grievance at their doorsteps District Development Commissioner Ganderbal, Dr. Piyush Singla held first “public Darbar at Wakoora, here today. SSP, Mr. Fayaz Ahmad Lone, Additional District



Development Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner, District officers, representatives of Peoples Welfare Society Ganderbal and large number of local citizen participated.

Locals apprised officers regarding Public grievances being confronted by them and officers heard them patiently and then responded them in light of yearly targets fixed by respective departments. Public grievances were mainly related to road connectivities, Construction of link road and their macadamization, restoration/renovation and regulation of water supplies, renovation and maintenance of Power Supply, health Care, transportation facilities, irrigation facilities, provisions of food grain and other civic amenities.

Responding to the power supply complaints Executive Engineer PDD apprised Public Darbar that as many as 1200 electric poles have been erected in the area, damaged transformers have been replaced by fresh ones. The department accords priority to restore HT lines and LT lines. DPR's for installation of street lights in areas of Dub, Butwina and other localities of Wakora are submitted to higher authorities for approval.

Macadamization of main road and link roads in Wakura area are being taken in hand shortly where as these works are executed in phases manners as per availability of funds and works are at different stages of DPR and tenders.

DDC enjoined engineers of Irrigation and Flood Control to prioritize renovation and cleanliness of Dub Canal and other Canal to boost agriculture and Horticulture sectors in the area. Besides awareness Camp of agriculture and horticulture be organized at Tehsil level.

Almost all old and rusted PHE pipes are being removed by fresh stock to improve water supply in the area, executive Engineers PHE apprised the Darbar.

To serve People at their doorsteps, the DDC Ganderbal, Dr. Piyush Singla today listened to issues of locals at a public grievances redressal camp under the banner “Aap ki



Sarkar – Aap Dwar” held in Tehsil Kangan of District Ganderbal. A Large number of people projected their demands related to road connectivity, water supply, power infrastructure and other basic amenities.

SSP Ganderbal, Mr. Fayaz Ahmad Lone, Additional District Development Commissioner, N.A Baba, SDM Kangan, ACR Ganderbal, District officers, and a huge gathering of local citizen of Kangan participated.

Most of the public demands were pertaining to the provision of safe drinking water supply, rational and speedy ration supply, removal of encroachments from various irrigation canals, desilting of various canals, upgradation of link roads, unplugging of drains, power facility and proper upkeep of transformers, transportation facility, decongestion of the town, beautification and sanitation of the town, proper manning of various SDHs and PHCs, construction of culverts and flood protection bunds.

The Deputy Commissioner, on the occasion, gave a patient hearing to the public grievances & issued on spot directions to concerned officers for their immediate redressal. He said District Administration wants to give people a feel of good governance for which every department has to put in extra efforts. The Deputy Commissioner assured the time-bound redressal of grievances and directed the concerned officers to furnish the action taken report within a week. Responding to the power supply complaints Executive Engineer PDD apprised Public Darbar that the department accords priority to restore HT lines and LT lines. DPR's for repair of street lights in areas of Kangan will be submitted to higher authorities for approval.

The Darbar was attended by SSP Ganderbal, Mr. Fayaz Ahmad Lone, Additional District Development Commissioner, N.A Baba, S.D.M Kangan, CEO Sonamarg Development Authority, CPO Ganderbal, Exen R&B, I&FC, PDD, District Horticulture Officer, ARTO, DSWO, DFO Sindh and other officers from police and civil administration.



Locals apprised officers regarding Public grievances being confronted by them and officers heard them patiently and then responded to all the grievances and queries of the local masses. Public grievances were mainly related to road connectivities, restoration/renovation and regulation of water supplies, renovation and maintenance of Power Supply, health Care, transportation facilities, irrigation facilities, winter stocking of food grains in snow bound areas, land acquisition issues, land compensation issues, demand for employment as non-skilled workers by locals in Z-Morh Tunnel Project and other civic amenities.

While assuring a playground for Gund Tehsil, the DDC called for identification of the land for this purpose. The DDC on the occasion stressed upon the officers to provide basic facilities to the people of Gund Tehsil. He said that District administration is committed to provide every facility to the people of the district. DDC said that full support will be provided to the unemployed youth of the area for promoting their welfare. DDC said that government has lunched various schemes and programmes for the people and they should come forward and take the benefits of the developmental programme and schemes. The DDC assured the people

of the area that their problems will be solved at an earliest and directed the concerned officers to furnish the action taken report within a week.

Responding to the power supply complaints, DDC apprised people that 70 lacs of CDF funds for improvement of HT&LT at critical spots already indentified in Kangan Constituency has been released. This shall be in addition to the routine schemes which are carried by PDD department like transmission and distribution, replacement of barbed wire schemes etc. People were also assured about the shifting of HT and LT lines which hover as a major threat for school building and the students of Government High School Sumbal. Further Executive Engineer PDD appraised the darbar that during last six months 125 poles and 25 kilometers of ACSR conductor has been replaced at the required locations for overall improvement of LT/HT network. People also appreciated the efforts of District administration in holding first of its kind, pubic darbar in this Gund area.

Later, DDC Ganderbal thanked the locals for playing a very significant role not only in providing a safe environment in the entire Shri Amarnathji Yatra 2017 but also in providing physical support to the pilgrims to undertake the difficult journey to the Holy Cave.
